Day by day itinerary:

Friday 10 September 2021

Today make your own way to the Canberra Airport to board the private chartered flight from Canberra to Uluru. This is the only way you can travel directly from Canberra to Uluru with no stopovers. On board you will enjoy complimentary non-alcoholic drinks plus tea and coffee.


After disembarking the plane you will be picked up by your coach to check in to your hotel. You will be provided with lunch served at the hotel and have the afternoon free to explore.

Accommodation: Sails in the Desert - 2 night stay

Saturday 11 September 2021

This morning is free for you to explore Uluru at your own pace. Speak with our consulants about





adding on a scenic flight or other tours on this day.

This afternoon, you'll begin a sightseeing tour of Uluru and surrounds. Over the next 2 hours you will travel in air-conditioned comfort with views of Uluru and more. Please bring at least 1 litre of water, hat, sunscreen, enclosed walking shoes, warm layers in cooler months, flynet and insect repellant in summer months (optional).

This evening's Field of Light experience begins 2 hours after sunset with a convenient hotel pick-up and short transfer to the remote desert location. Arrive after dark to witness 50,000 slender stems crowned with radiant frosted-glass spheres gently bloom with rhythms of coloured light. Temporarily



lose yourself in this monumental light installation as its pathways draw you in.

Sunday 12 September 2021

This morning is at your leisure to explore more. Enjoy a 2-course lunch including a didgeridoo performance before being transferred back to the Ayers Rock Airport where you will board the private chartered jet to return to Canberra. Upon arrival into Canberra, this marks the end of your weekend getaway at Uluru.

COVID Strategy

To manage the public health risk posed by COVID-19, we are following a strict COVID strategy in line with the Government's requirements as follows:

- The airports have been set up with increased cleaning throughout all areas, queue management & distancing measures, masks and gloves worn by security offers & hand sanitising stations across the airport.
- On board the plane, you will be supplied with hand sanitiser as well as an individually wrapped mask.
- Please note that travellers from outside the Northern Territory will be required to obtain a travel permit prior to entering NT. In
 order to obtain a travel permit, please complete this online form within 72 hours prior to travel. A copy of your completed border
 entry form, in printed form, will need to be shown to staff. If you don't show your NT border arrival form you cannot board the
 plane.
- At Ayers Rock Resort, there are a number of measures in place to protect individuals visiting the Resort and also ensure guests have a safe and enjoyable stay.
- When you arrive at Ayers Rock Airport, the NT border arrivals team will process your border entry form and may ask you additional questions. You will be required to sign the declaration in front of an authorised officer.
